This responds to your initial Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) dated August 8, 2011, which was received in this office on August 10, 2011, as well as your amended request received on the same day. Your requests asks for "[a]ll photographs taken at the White House complex on May 1 and May 2, 2011 pertaining to the planning, review, execution, debriefing and public announcement of the Osama bin Laden operation in Abbottabad, Pakistan, by the President, his staff, members of other agencies and consultants." Specifically, "...those ranging in number by White House photographer Pete Souza from P05011PS-0106 to P05011PS-0522...."

"Added 10 August 2011: The photographs should be digital in their original, full resolution with complete EXIF data."

After reviewing your request, OMB conducted a search of its files, and no records responsive to your request were identified.

If you consider this to be a denial of your request, you may appeal this response in accordance with OMB regulations, at 5 C.F. R. § 1303.
